

Mango Crop Forecast Updated March 3, 2010

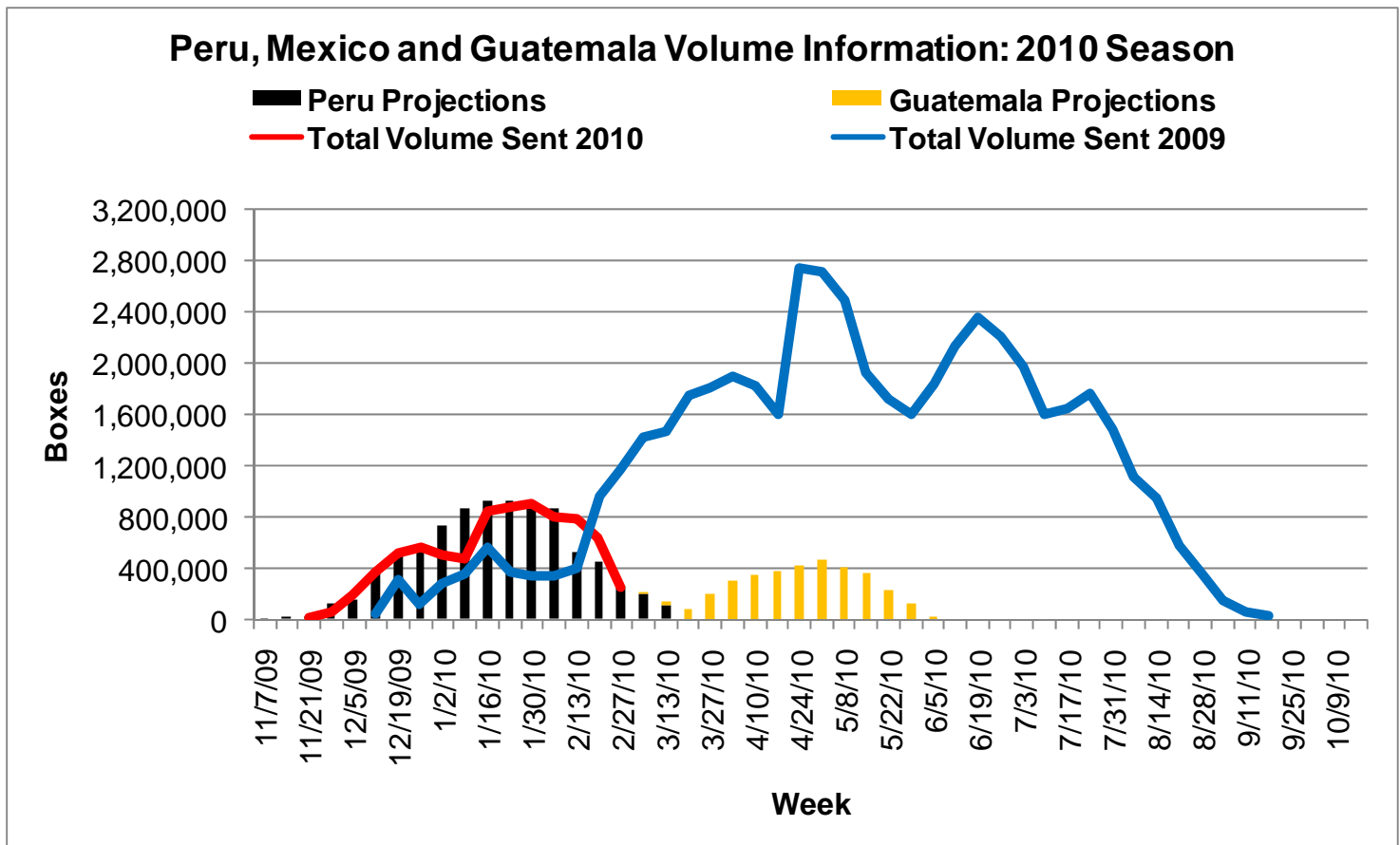
The Crop Forecast is updated regularly and can be found at mango.org/crop.

Please note: In the absence of a projection, from Mexico the graph above shows only 2009 and 2010 volume sent from Mexico.

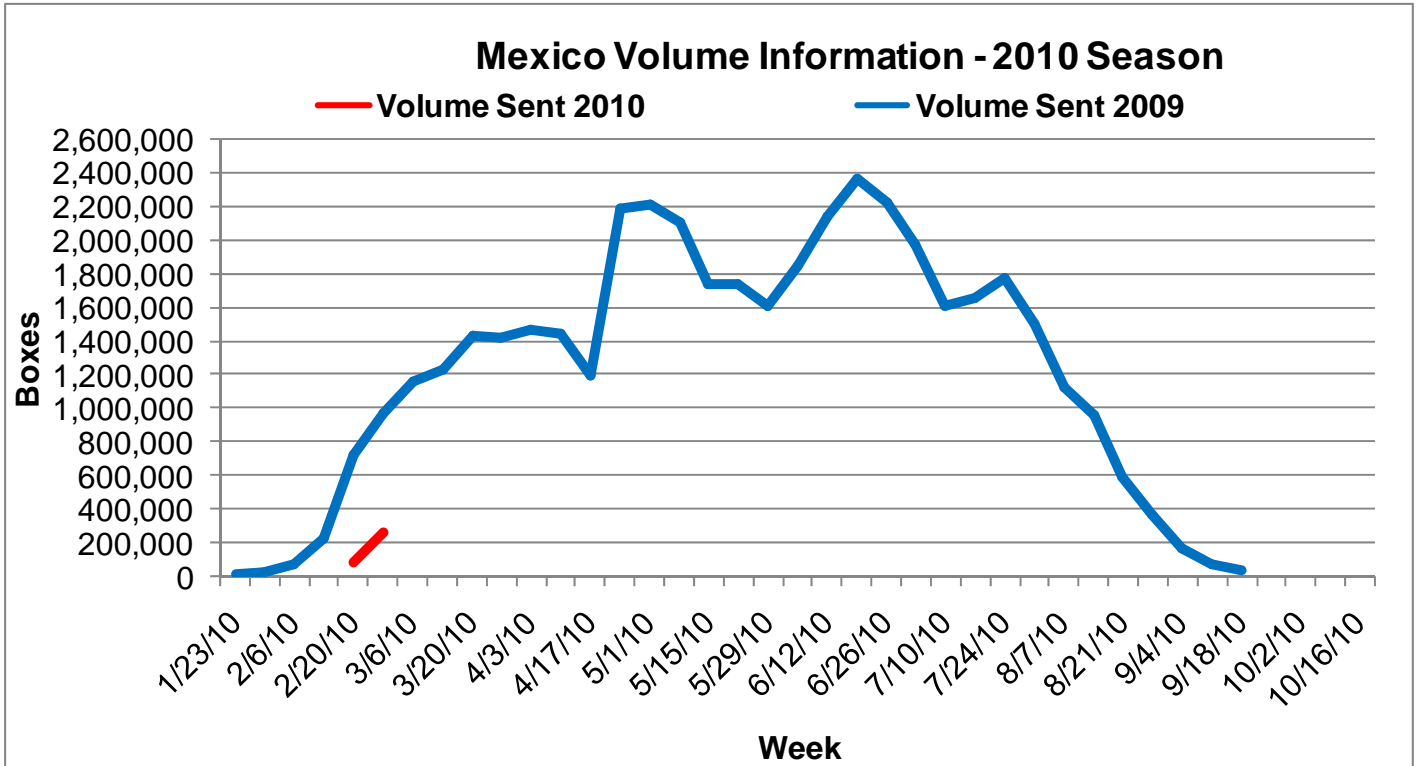

Mexico: The 2010 Mexican mango season will run later than usual due to weather conditions. Shipments started with small volumes in late February. Volume should begin to increase with the first peak of the season falling in April through mid-May. Projections for Mexico will be published as soon as the information is received from EMEX.

Mexico Weekly Volume by Variety (% of Boxes)

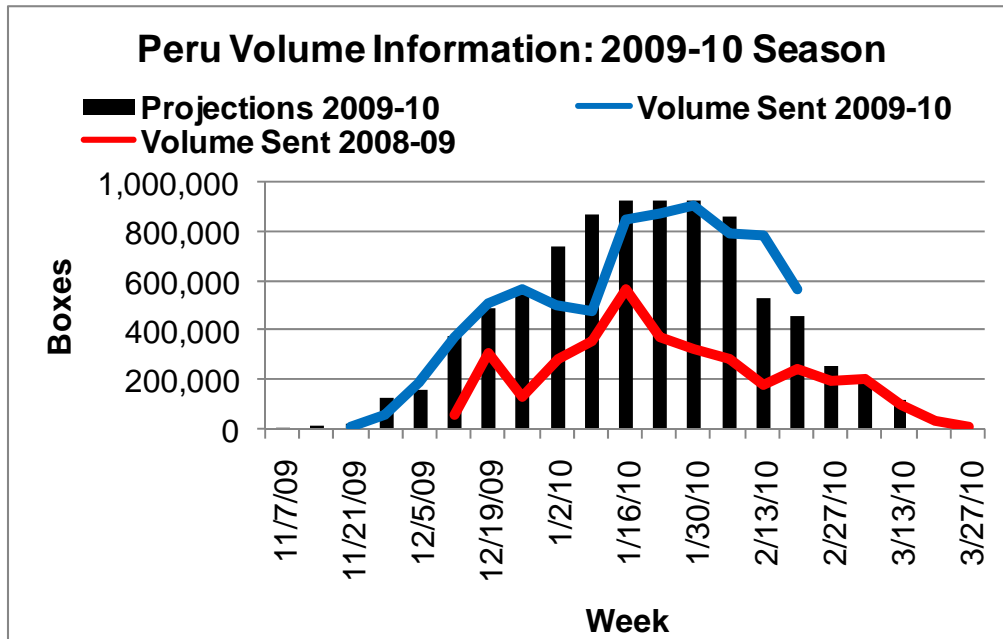

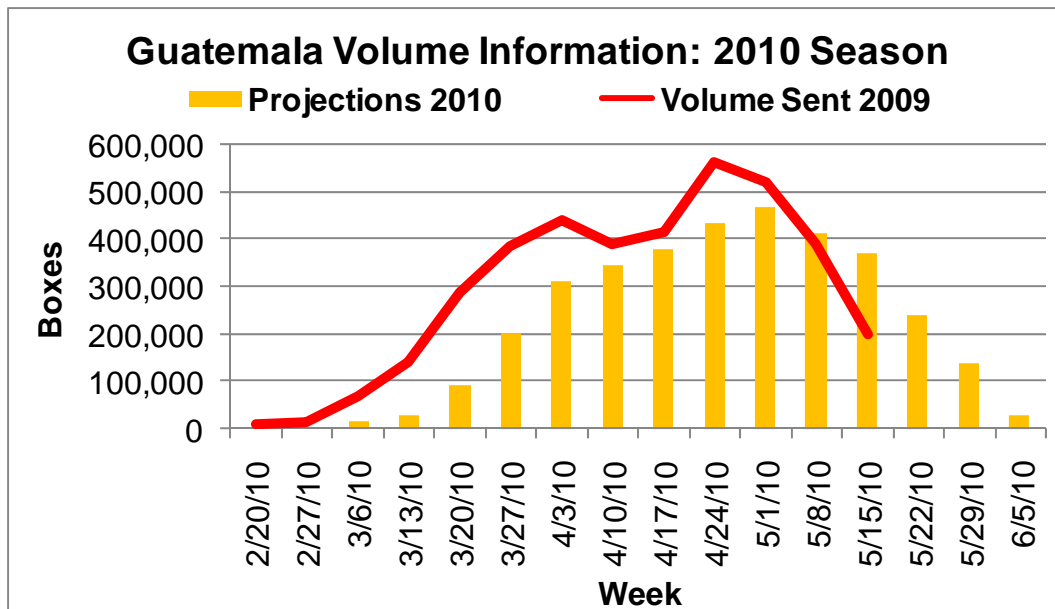

Peru: The Peruvian season began the beginning of November and will run until the end of March with approximately 8 million boxes. High volume from Peru is expected in January. During the last four seasons Peru has sent approximately 60% of the volume to the East Coast and 40% to the West Coast. Projections will be adjusted during the season.

Guatemala: The 2010 Guatemalan mango season will start the beginning of March and run until the end of May with approximately 3.5 million boxes. Five packing houses will be operating throughout the season. It is projected that 95% of the volume will be Tommy Atkins and 5% will be Ataulfo. Projections will be adjusted during the season.
