

# Mango Crop Report

## Updated October 20, 2011

The National Mango Board is working with organizations in the mango-producing countries to get projections of what will be shipped to the U.S. This document contains information from the countries currently shipping or planning to ship in the near future to the United States and does not represent the entire year. **Mango shipped volume last week was approximately 816,808 boxes representing 76.16% more than the previous week.**

### Mexico

- **Congratulations to Mexico for a successful season ending on October 4, 2011 with the record volume of approximately 55.7 million boxes. Thanks to “EMEX” and “Consejo Estatal de Productores de Mango de Sinaloa” and especially to Mr. Armando Celis, Mr. Ismael Perez, Ms. Myrna Castro and Mr. Daniel Luque for their contribution to the NMB Crop Report.**

### Brazil

- **Brazil sent approximately 593,208 boxes last week representing approximately 88% more than the previous week.**
- **Tommy Atkins weekly average price per box at the Philadelphia entry port on week ending on 10/15/2011 decreased by at least 13%.**
- **Transit times for shipments coming from Brazil have been inconsistent.**
- Brazil's season began the first part of August and will end in early November.
- Volume is expected to be approximately 6.3 million boxes (8.8 lb/box).
- Tommy Atkins will make up more than 95% of the volume from Brazil.
- Shipments take 2-3 weeks to arrive in the U.S.

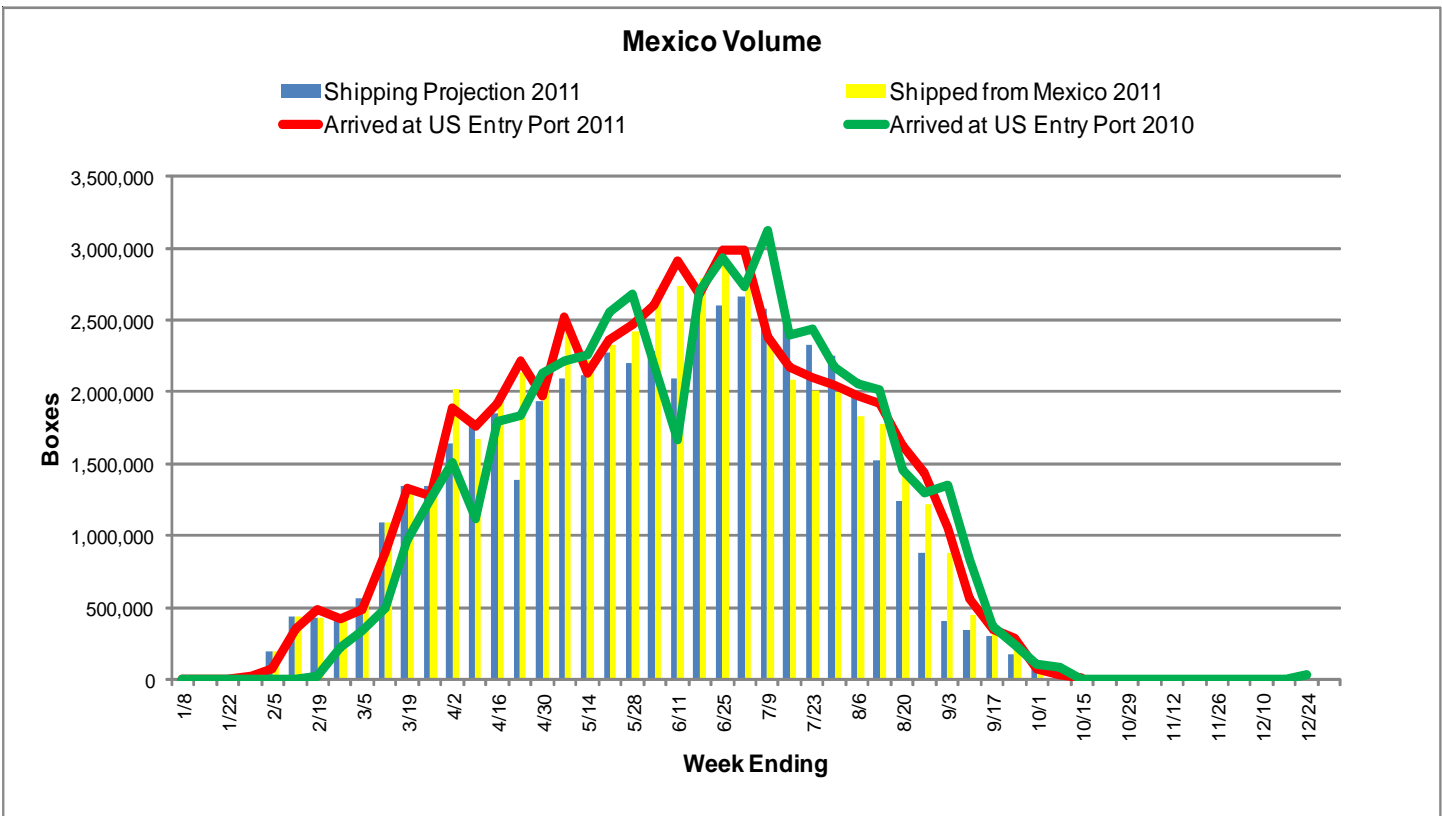
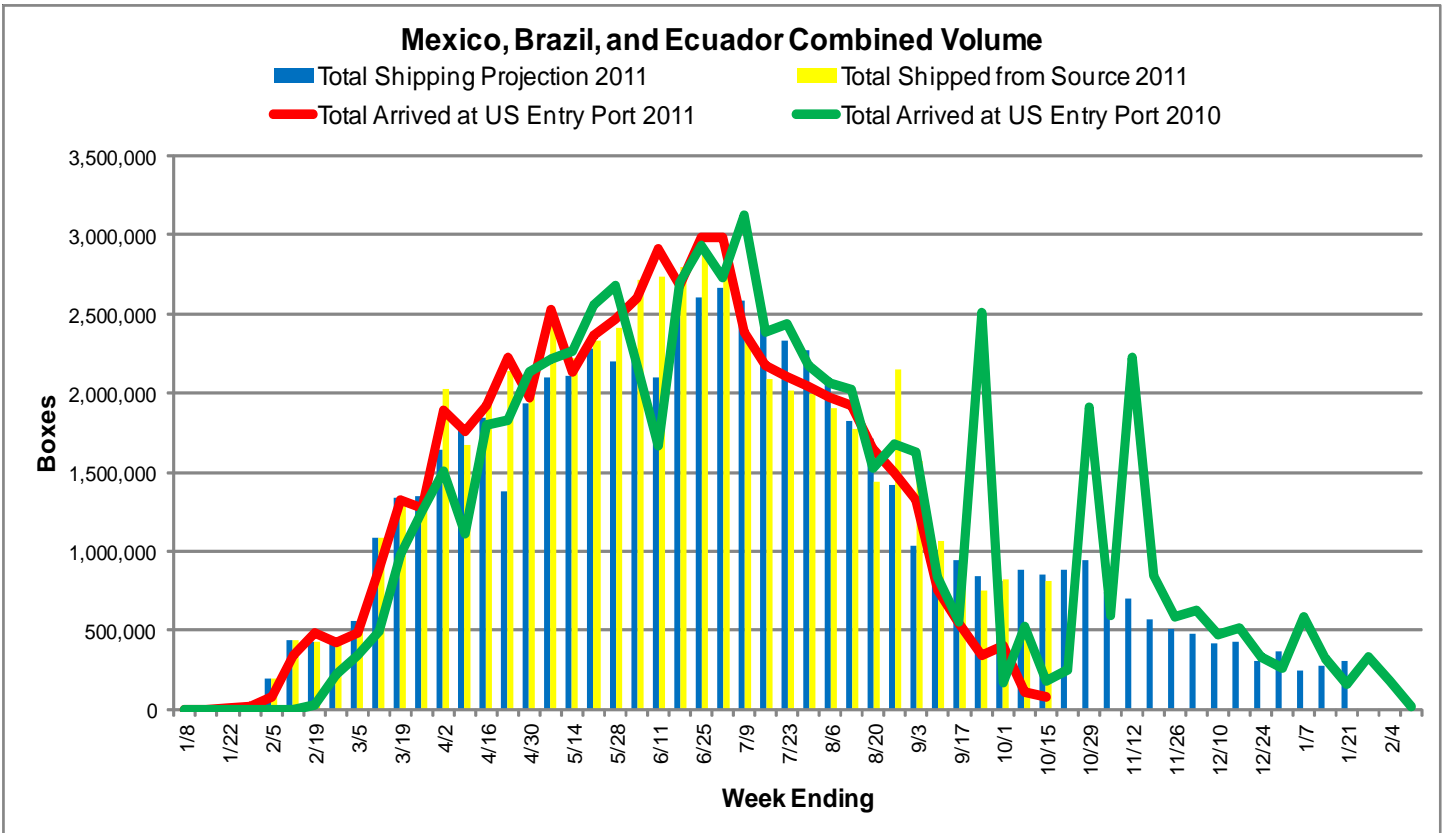
### Ecuador

- **Ecuador sent approximately 223,600 boxes last week representing approximately 79.17% more than the previous week. Estimated volume for this week and next week will be approximately 631,857 and 745,211 boxes respectively.**
- Ecuador's season began early October and will run through mid January with approximately 7.2 million boxes. High volumes from Ecuador are expected between November and mid December.

All projections will be adjusted throughout the season.

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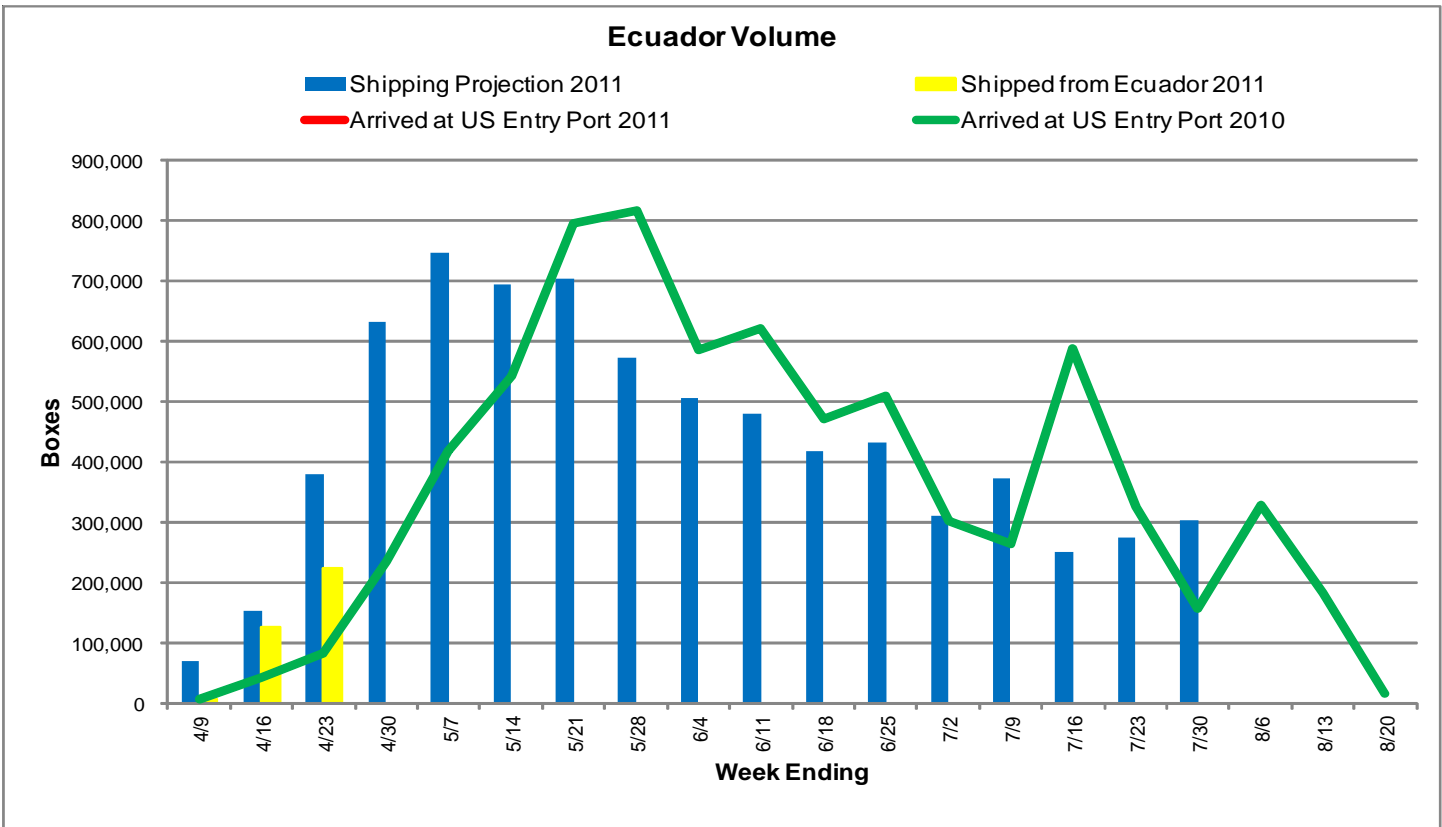
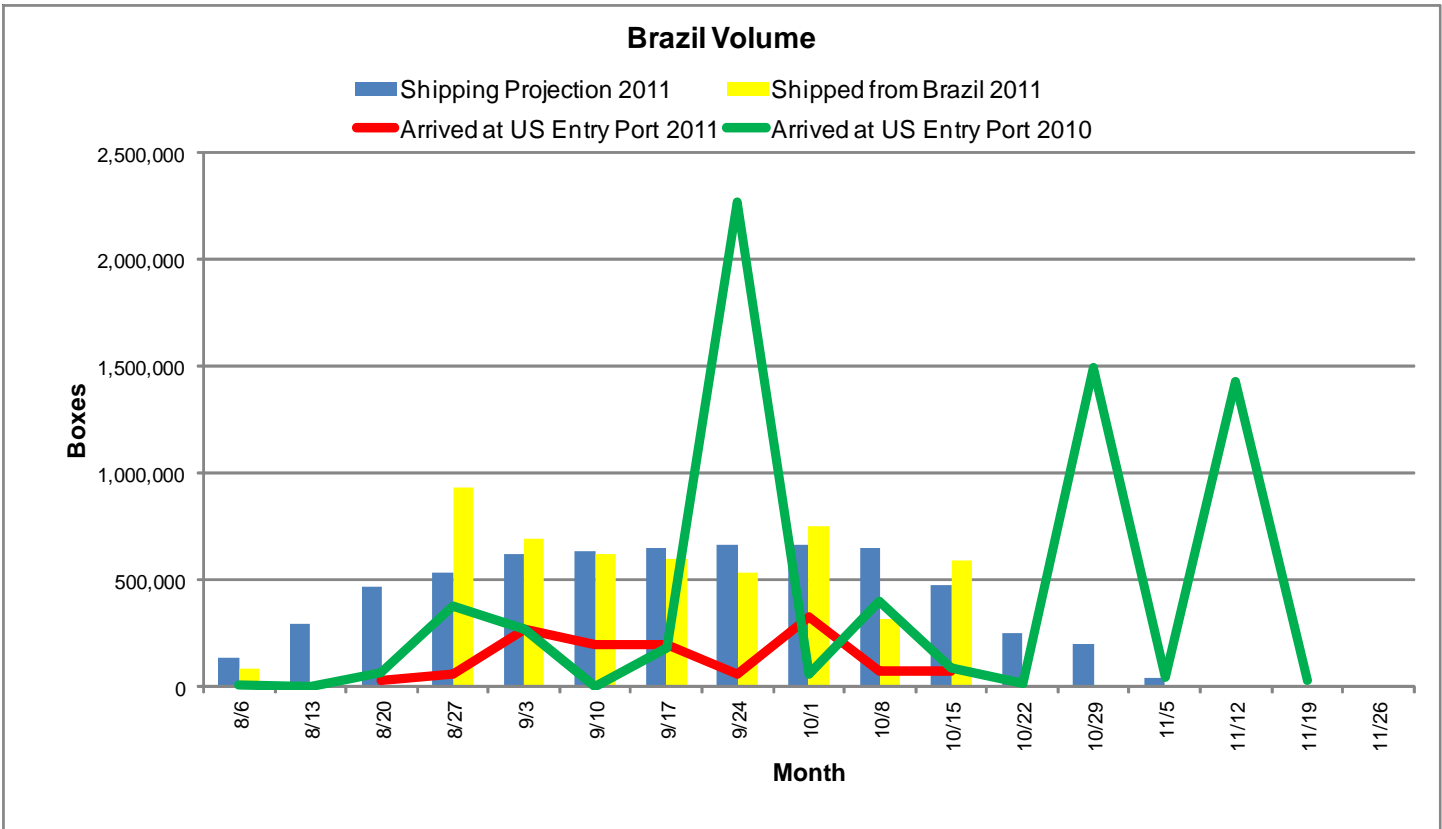
