

MANGO CROP REPORT

Updated January 24, 2020

The National Mango Board (NMB) publishes the Mango Crop Report on a regular basis using information from industry organizations and other sources in an effort to provide the best available information on shipment projections, actual arrivals, variety and size availability, and other figures considered useful to the U.S. mango market. Although this information is updated regularly, changes can occur due to numerous factors at any given moment in time. Accordingly, the Mango Crop Report should only be used as a guide.


Ecuador, Peru and Mexico Crop Information

- **EXPORTING REGIONS:** Ecuador ended its season the third week of January. Peru and Mexico are currently harvesting and packing. See pages 3-6, 7-9 and 10-11 respectively.
- **VARIETIES:** There is currently ONE main mango variety available in the market: Kent (99%). There are also limited supplies of Tommy Atkins and Keitt. See pages 2, 4 and 8.
- **SIZING:** (Ataulfo/Honey: Large = size 16 and larger, Small = size 18 and smaller. Round mangos: Extra Large = 7 and larger, Large = sizes 8 and 10, Small = 12 and smaller.)
 - **Ecuador:** 2% of Tommy Atkins are Extra large, 64% are Large and 34% are Small; 10% of Kent are Extra Large, 72% are Large and 18% are Small; 35% of Keitt are Large and 65% are Small. See tables on page 8.
- **VOLUMES:** Overall mango volume from week 4 to week 13 is expected to be 1% lower year-over-year, with arrivals expected from week 5 to week 14

Overall volume from Peru is projected to be 32% higher than last year. Volume from Mexico (up to week 13) is projected to be 4% lower than last year. See page 2 for total volumes, and pages 4, 8 and 11 for individual country volume. Week description (date) can also be found in pages 2, 4, 8 and 11.

Mango volume shipped on week ending 1/18/2020 was approximately 2,446,241 boxes.

- During the same week last year, volume shipped was approximately 1,641,976 boxes.



Please note: U.S. entry ports report incoming mango volume on different schedules; some report daily and some weekly. This will cause discrepancies between the volume shipped from the source and the volume arrived at the U.S. entry ports in any given week.


All projections will be adjusted throughout the season as new information is received.


Volume on week ending 1/18/2020



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
Peru Crop Information

- The Peruvian mango season began the third week of November (2019) and will run until the fourth week of March (2020) with a projection of approximately **15** million boxes.
- Peru's main varieties are Kent (97%), Tommy Atkins (2%) and Ataulfo (1%).

Volume on week ending 1/18/2020

- Volume shipped from Peru was approximately **2,352,917** boxes for a total of **10,275,977** boxes for the season.
- * During the same week last year, volume shipped from Peru was 1,594,102 boxes for a total of 6,645,267 boxes.
- **Peru's volume arrival data on the USDA-AMS website is not currently reflecting the Volume shipped (incomplete data). The updated information will be posted as soon as it becomes available.**





Mexico Crop Information

- The Mexican mango season is expected to begin the fourth week of January and run until approximately the first week of October. Volume projections up to week 13 (ending on 3/18/2020) are expected to be approximately **9** million boxes.
- **Projections after week 13 will be posted as soon as they are available.**
- Mexico's main varieties are Kent (29%), Tommy Atkins (29%), Ataulfo (23%), Keitt (15%), Haden (3%) and other (1%).


