

MANGO CROP REPORT


Updated July 3rd, 2025

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The National Mango Board (NMB) publishes the Mango Crop Report on a regular basis using information from industry organizations and other sources in an effort to provide the best available information on shipment projections, actual arrivals, variety and size availability, and other figures considered useful to the U.S. mango market. Although this information is updated regularly, changes can occur due to numerous factors at any given moment in time. Accordingly, the Mango Crop Report should only be used as a guide.

SUMMARY: Mexico and Dominican Republic

- ◆ **EXPORTING REGIONS:** Mexico and Dominican Republic are currently harvesting and/or packing.
- ◆ **VARIETIES:** There are currently **THREE** main mango varieties shipped to the US market: Kent (59%), Tommy Atkins (21%) and Ataulfo/Honey (18%). There are also limited supply of Mingolo, Keitt, Malika, Nam Doc Mai, Thai, Manila, Banilejo and Kesar. See page 3.
- ◆ **SIZING:** (Ataulfo/Honey: Large = size 16 and larger, Small = size 18 and smaller. Round mangos: Extra Large = 7 and larger, Large = sizes 8 and 10, Small = 12 and smaller.)
- ◆ **RECENT VOLUMES:** Total mango volume shipped on week ending **06/28/2025** was approximately **4,578,808 boxes**.
 - ◇ **Mexico:** Volume shipped was approximately **4,471,030** boxes for a total of **63,564,782** boxes for the season.
 - ◇ **Dominican Republic:** Volume shipped was approximately **107,778** boxes for a total of **1,822,208** boxes for the season.
- ◆ **FUTURE VOLUMES:** Overall mango volume shipped from week 27 (07/05/2025) to week 31 (08/02/2025) is expected to be about 13% higher YOY, with arrivals expected from week 28 to 32. The 2025 Mexican season is expected to be about 13% higher YOY.



Please note: U.S. entry ports report incoming volume on different schedules; some report daily and some weekly. This causes discrepancies between the volume shipped from the source and the volume arrived at the U.S. entry ports in any given week.

Projections are adjusted throughout the season as new information is received.




Mexico Crop Information

- The Mexico mango season began the second week of January and will run until the last week of September with a projection of approximately **101 million** boxes.
- Mexico's main varieties are: Tommy Atkins (40%), Ataulfo/Honey (28%), Kent (22%), Keitt (7%) and others (3%)

Volume on week ending 06/28/2025

- Volume shipped from Mexico was approximately **4,471,030** boxes for a total of **63,564,782** boxes for the season.
- During the same week in 2024, volume shipped from Mexico was **4,274,028** boxes for a total of **55,456,457** boxes.












